



Jamboree



The WCC Bluegrass & Old-Time Jamboree is held every third Saturday of the month, except in the month of June, at 7 p.m. in the Snyder Auditorium, Grayson Hall, on the main WCC campus in Wytheville.

The Bluegrass & Old-Time Jamboree was organized beginning in October of 2006 by WCC President Charlie White, who organized and hosted a similar event for many years at New River Community College. Each Jamboree features a bluegrass band and an old-time band. The bluegrass band usually performs from 7-8 p.m. and the old-time band usually performs from 8-9 p.m. Room is provided for anyone who wants to shake a leg and dance.

The event is **free and open to the public**. Donations are accepted to help defray the travel expenses of the bands.

The next Jamboree will be held on **Saturday, January 17, 2015** in the Snyder Auditorium. Seating is available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Performers will be **Jerry Steinburg & His Dixie Blue Grass Boys** at 7 p.m. and the **New Ballard's Branch Bogtrotters** at 8 p.m.
