Cost of Attendance

Cost of Attendance (COA) is the total amount it will cost you to go to school at full-time status (12 or more credits)—usually expressed as a yearly figure. It's determined using rules established by the Department of Education.

The COA includes tuition and fees, room and board, allowances for books and supplies, transportation, personal expenses, and, if applicable, loan fees.

For students attending between one and five credits (less than half-time), the COA includes tuition and fees and an allowance for books, supplies, and transportation. It can also include room and board for up to three semesters or the equivalent at the institution, but no more than two of those semesters or the equivalent may be consecutive.
