- **Transcripts are REQUIRED from ALL colleges or universities previously attended and must be received by the admission deadline.**
- Credit for MTE 1-5 will be given to students who have completed MTH 154 (or equivalent) or higher prior to the deadline or who have placed out of these MTE units via the Virginia Placement Test (VPT) or multiple measures (high school GPA, SAT, etc.)
- Credit will be given to students who have completed college-level English or who have placed out of ENF units via the VPT or multiple measures. All required ENF courses must be completed before the deadline so the student is ready to enter ENG 111 with the exception of Nursing: ENG 111 is a pre-requisite course and must be completed by the deadline for admission.
- Students who have successfully completed equivalent college-level Math and/or English coursework or who have submitted qualifying official GED, ACT, SAT, or AP scores for Math and/or English will be exempt from developmental courses. All students should consult an advisor to determine their need for developmental courses. If it is determined that the student places into MTE units 1, 2, 3, 4 and/or 5; and/or ENF units 2 or 3, these courses will have to be completed by the deadline.
