

Police Officer

Town of Pulaski, Virginia

The Pulaski Police Department, an agency accredited by the Virginia Law Enforcement Professional Standards Commission, is seeking Police Officer candidates for current vacancies. Officers are responsible for the enforcement of laws and ordinances pursuant to the Town, State and Federal Governments, as well as, providing assistance to the public. Officers are subjected to hazardous and life threatening situations and must be able to work as a team member and maintain a good relationship with fellow employees. Officers are required to work nights, weekends and holidays.

Qualifications include graduation from high school, must be twenty-one years of age upon graduation from the Training Academy, and possess a valid Virginia's driver's license with a good driving record. Must successfully complete applicant testing and an extensive background investigation. The successful candidate must reside within forty-five minutes of the town limits. Additional qualifications and disqualifiers for employment as a Law Enforcement Officer may be obtained with the application form.

Excellent benefits, to include paid health, dental and vision insurance, life insurance, disability insurance and retirement plans. A minimum of thirteen paid holidays per year, two personal days off, vacation hours accrual and sick leave are also provided. Employee benefits also include assigned vehicles, which may be utilized as a take home vehicle if residing within an approved location. All equipment is furnished. College tuition assistance available. Applicants are guaranteed a minimum 5% pay raise after successfully completing the 12 month probationary period and a second minimum 5% pay raise with acceptable performance evaluations after their third year of employment. These raises are in addition to other pay raises that may be provided by the Town during this period.
