Apply for Admission to WCC

Application for Dual Enrollment Students:

If you have taken dual enrollment classes while in high school, you are already considered a WCC student.

Check with Admissions at admissions@wcc.vccs.edu or 276-223-4701 to verify application status.

If your application is active, you will **only** need to complete a high school transition form instead of an application.

(Free Application for Federal Student Aid)

If you are attending Summer 2023 semester, please select the 2022-2023 FAFSA application.

You will also need to complete the 2023-2024 FAFSA application.

If you are attending Fall 2023 semester, please select the 2023-2024 FAFSA application.

2022-2023 FAFSA covers Fall 2022, Spring 2023, and Summer 2023 semesters.

2023-2024 FAFSA covers Fall 2023, Spring 2024, and Summer 2024 semesters.

Final High School Transcripts will also need to be sent to the Financial Aid Office and the Admissions Office from the High School after graduation.
