Complete a 26-27 FAFSA
(Free Application for Federal Student Aid)

FAFSA:

FAFSA for the 26-27 year covers Fall 26, Spring 27, and Summer 27 terms.

If you are attending Summer 2026 semester, you will also need to complete the **2025-2026 FAFSA** application.

Federal tax information will be needed from the 2024 filing year for the 26-27 FAFSA. Federal tax information will be needed from the 2023 filing year for the 25-26 FAFSA.

All Promise Programs require a complete current FAFSA and complete financial aid file. You will be notified by email for missing/incomplete items.

WCC will need a copy of your high school transcripts once you graduate high school. Your financial aid file will be incomplete until this occurs. You will need to request a copy of your transcripts be sent to WCC.
