**Congratulations on your upcoming high school graduation!** Enclosed is the application packet to apply for all scholarships, including the **Twin County Community Foundation Scholarship**. We encourage you to continue your education at Wytheville Community College, where you may qualify for **free tuition** and **save up to \$13,000 over the next two years!** The Twin County Community Foundation Scholarship is available as a "Last Dollar Scholarship", if you meet the following qualifications:

- Have been a resident of Carroll County, Grayson County, or the City of Galax for your junior and senior year of high school.
- Attended a Carroll County, Grayson County, or the City of Galax High School for your junior and senior years.
- Graduate high school with a minimum "B" (3.0) grade point average.

## **FREE TUITION**


To qualify for the Twin County Community Foundation Scholarship and to attend Wytheville Community College tuition-free, you will need to complete the following steps (please see the attached form to scan QR codes to be taken directly to each step of the application process):

- **Now** – Apply to WCC
  - If you are a dual enrollment student, you may only need to complete a High School Transition form.
- **Now** – Complete the 2023-2024 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
  - 2023-2024 FAFSA covers Fall 2023, Spring 2024, and Summer 2024 semesters
  - Financial aid information will be from the 2021 tax year
- **Beginning December 1, 2022** – Complete the Fall 2023 online WCC Scholarship Application. The application covers all scholarships, including the Twin County Community Foundation Scholarship.
  - Please explain any special circumstances in the essay portion of the application.
  - The priority *deadline* for completing the Fall 2023 Scholarship Application is **April 1, 2023**.
