**Current** Carroll County, Grayson County, and Galax High School Seniors, graduating in 2023

1.  **Apply for Admission to WCC**

If you have taken dual enrollment classes while in high school, you are already considered a WCC student. Check with Admissions at [admissions@wcc.vccs.edu](mailto:admissions@wcc.vccs.edu) or call 276-223-4701 to verify application status. If your application is active, you will **only** need to complete a high school transition form instead of an application.

(Free Application for Federal Student Aid)**

*You will also need to complete the 2023-2024 FAFSA application.*

If you are attending Fall 2023 semester, please select the 2023-2024 FAFSA application.  
*2022-2023 FAFSA covers Fall 2022, Spring 2023, and Summer 2023 semesters.*

(Final High School Transcripts will also need to be sent to the Financial Aid Office and the Admissions Office from the High School after graduation)

3.  **Complete a 2023 Fall Scholarship Application  
To apply for all WCC scholarships, including the  
Twin County Community Foundation Scholarship**

**April 3, 2023** – Registration for Fall 2023 begins.

*If you will be attending Summer 2023 – after you register for classes, please fill out a Summer 2023 Financial Aid Application that will be linked to your Student Information System (SIS) account.*

4.  **Register for Classes at WCC**

Registration for Summer 2023 is March 20, 2023, and Registration for Fall 2023 is April 3, 2023.

Even though you have not graduated from high school yet, please register for classes so we can process your Twin County Community Foundation Scholarship Application!
